

It's Fishing Season

Fishing often takes patience to be successful. Share a time in your life when your patience was rewarded, or share about something that you are still waiting for.

The Big Idea; Christ calls Peter and Andrew to ministry from their occupation (fishing) and promises He will make them fishers of men. In one of his last moments of teaching (John 21:4-19) He finds them again fishing **and** leaves Peter (the rock) with a powerful admonition.

Read Mathew 4:19 and Mark 1:17

What words denote a sense of urgency and inspiration?

Have you ever responded that quickly to Gods inspiration/direction/calling? Share the story.

What has been in “your hand” that God asked you to put down to follow Him?

Read John 21:4-19

Why do you think the disciples did not recognize Jesus Immediately?

Why would fishing on the right side of the boat have produced abundance when the left side produced none---what was the difference?

In Matthew 4 and Mark 1 Christ promises to make them fishers of men. In John 21 He encourages them (Peter specifically) to care for those men.

If Christ was sitting in the room with you right now.....how would you tell Him you have “fed His lambs”?

How could you do a better job of “feeding His lambs”?
