

Living the Whole Gospel (Wrap-up)

Isaiah 58

Ice Breaker: Describe a time when you entered into something with a sour attitude and you were surprised to experience a blessing or an insight you weren't expecting.

BIG IDEA: There is a deep connection between our serving the poor and marginalized – and the transformational work that God will do in us – as we serve them.

Key Scriptures:

- **Deuteronomy 15:1-11**

- **Isaiah 58**

Digging Deeper:

- 1) Take time to read the above Scriptures out loud together. What do these passages tell us about God, His perspective on the poor, the nature of faith, and what it means to follow Him?
- 2) What would it look like for WFMC to take seriously these Scriptures? What would it look like for your small group to take seriously these Scriptures? What would it look like for you (individually) to take seriously these Scriptures?
- 3) There was a lot of prayer leading up to “Be the Church” Sunday - that Jesus would be lifted up through our service. Let's be careful to give God praise for the incredible things He did through us – and pray that the ripple effect of this day would continue to point our community to Christ.
