- 4) Start attending the course on ‘The Hole in our Gospel’ that began last Sunday.

- 5) Connect with one of the many Isaiah 58 front-line ministries in our community:
 - The Lighthouse
 - Haven of Hope
 - Hospitality House
 - Solomon’s Porch
 - Serve Wenatchee Valley
 - Salvation Army

- 6) Go to www.servewenatchee.org to sign up to participate in this Saturday’s Serve Fest - another opportunity to bless our community in Jesus’ name.

- 7) Sign up to receive our Volunteer Opportunities email. If you’re not yet receiving this email, put your email address on the connection card, and we’ll send it to you.

- 8) Go to www.sisterconnection.org – to learn about what God is doing in Burundi. Pray about how God would have you participate in this transformation story.

- 9) Start praying and saving to buy (or contribute toward) a \$600 house to be built for a homeless widow in Burundi. This coming Christmas season, our focus will be on seeing how many houses we can build for homeless widows in Burundi.
