Mark 14:32-15:38

1) What was Jesus recoiling from when he prayed: “Take this cup from me” (Mark 14:36)?

- The cup of God’s _____ that would be poured out upon Him as He took the punishment for every sin that’s ever been (and ever will be) committed.

2) Why did the Father turn His face away from Jesus – as He died (Mark 15:34)?

- The _____ of the whole world were being placed on Him.

3) What’s the significance of Jesus crying out, “It is finished!” – as He died?

- This phrase (“Tetelestai”) was a 1st century commercial term that literally meant: “the _____ has been paid in full.”

No matter what you've done or how large the accumulated debt of your sin, the good news is that what Christ did on the cross is sufficient for all of it to be forgiven!

The Invitation:

Let go of your own futile attempts to “pay down” your sin debt – and instead – surrender your life to Christ and put your trust in His finished work on the cross.
